The evidence was presented by a stipulation agreed to by the Commonwealth and the defendant.

The Court found the defendant GUILTY of Possession of Psilocybin, as charged; §18.2-250 A(a).


Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.
